ENHANCEMENT

- Added Voicemail support. [VOICEMAIL]
- Added Department and Sub-Department view support for Contacts.
- Added the ability to customize the user's profile picture. [CUSTOMIZABLE PROFILE PICTURE]
- Added *Help and Feedback* option. *Export Logs* option has been moved to this new section.
- Added ability to sync call history with other Wave endpoints registered to the same account.
- Merged audio and video meetings to reflect changes on UCM63xx fw 1.0.11.9.
- Added several new chat features:
 - Replying with emoji
 - Typing indicators
 - Added more emojis
 - Added support for @ mentions
 - Limit the chat history that can be viewed by new chat group members
 - Added meeting chat preview bubbles for new messages. [MEETING CHAT PREVIEW BUBBLES]
- Optimized the push notification process for Wave Android.
- Added *Ignore power-saving optimization* option to the *Settings* page. This option will keep the app running in the background at the cost of higher battery consumption.
- Made several UI improvements.
- Added *Smart Device* feature to manage other IP devices. [SMART DEVICE]

BUG FIXES

- Fixed an issue where the packet loss information would be incorrect.
- [Android only] Updated required permissions.

KNOWN ISSUES

- If the user joins the audio conference held by another UCM63xx server through the Wave mobile app, the user cannot view the participant list and chat after joining the meeting.
- Abnormal behavior may occur if the UCM's Cloud IM settings are modified or if the UCM is upgraded. If this occurs, the user must log out of the account and log back in to the Wave mobile app.
- Due to several issues discovered with the meeting talking indicator, the feature has been temporarily disabled.
- If certain audio/video codecs configurations are set on the UCM63xx (e.g. only G.726 as audio codec), Wave may experience abnormal behavior.
- Wave Android application may not receive push notification within 1 minute when the application screen is locked.

NEW FEATURES OVERVIEW

VOICEMAIL

Voicemail can now be viewed and played directly from Wave. The **Voicemail** tab has been added under the **Calls** page.

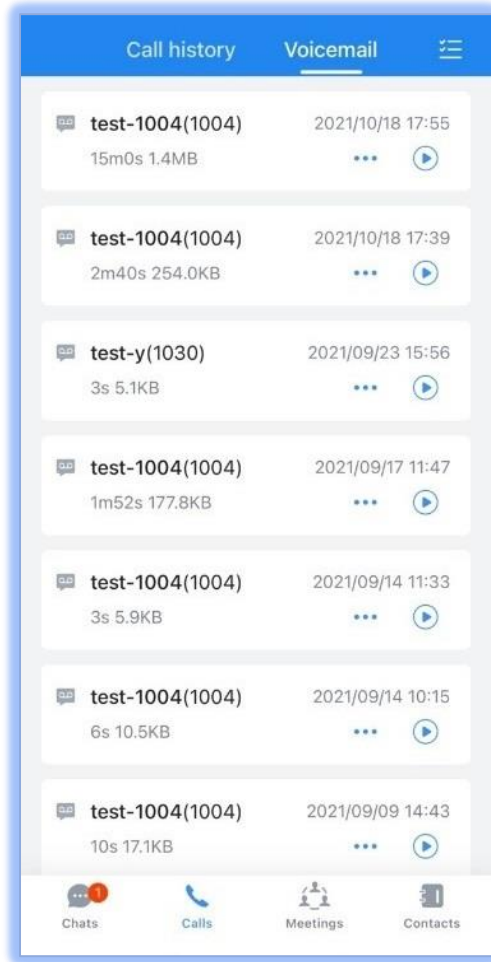


Figure 1 - Wave Voicemail

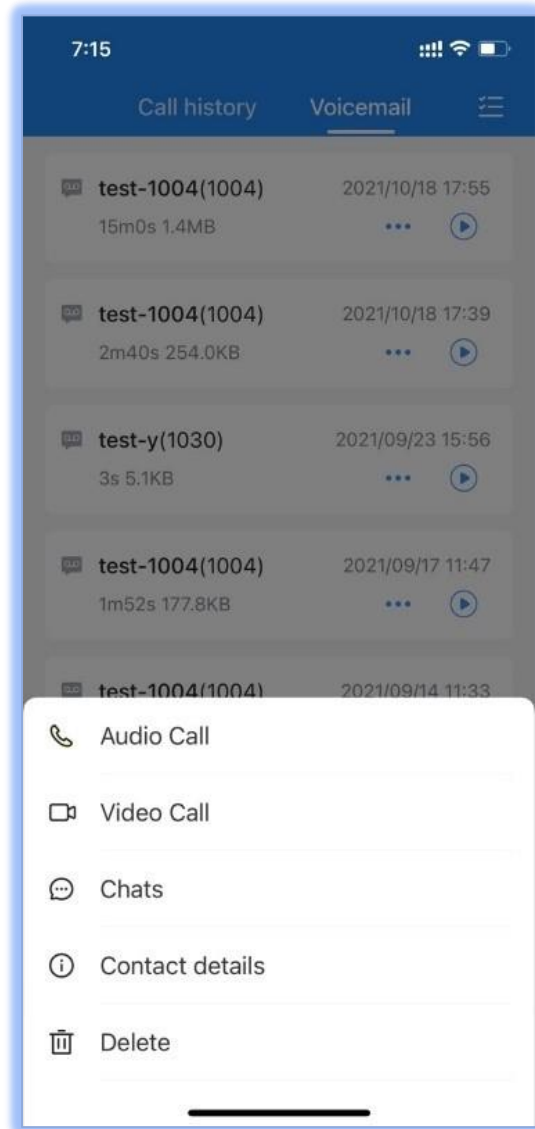


Figure 2 - Voicemail More Options

If users click on the ... button next to the Play button of a voicemail, the above options will appear.

CUSTOMIZABLE PROFILE PICTURE

Users can now customize their profile pictures, which will be visible by others in the Contacts list, chats, and meetings. To change profile picture, tap on the account icon at the top right corner of the app. In the next page, click on the top section with profile picture.

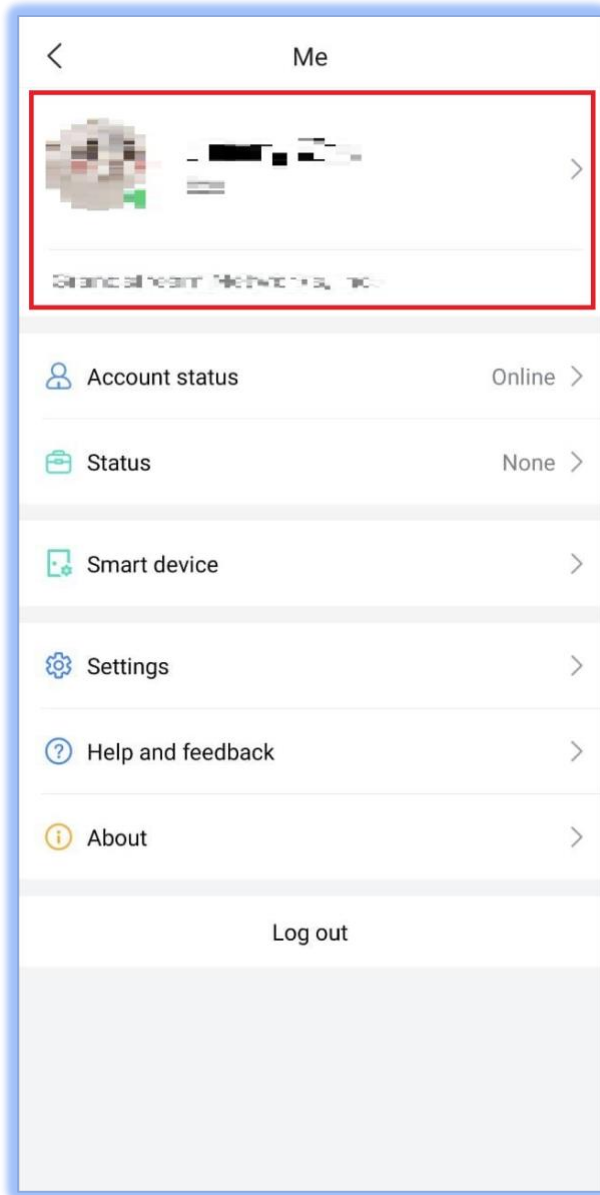


Figure 4 - Me Page

The following page will then appear:

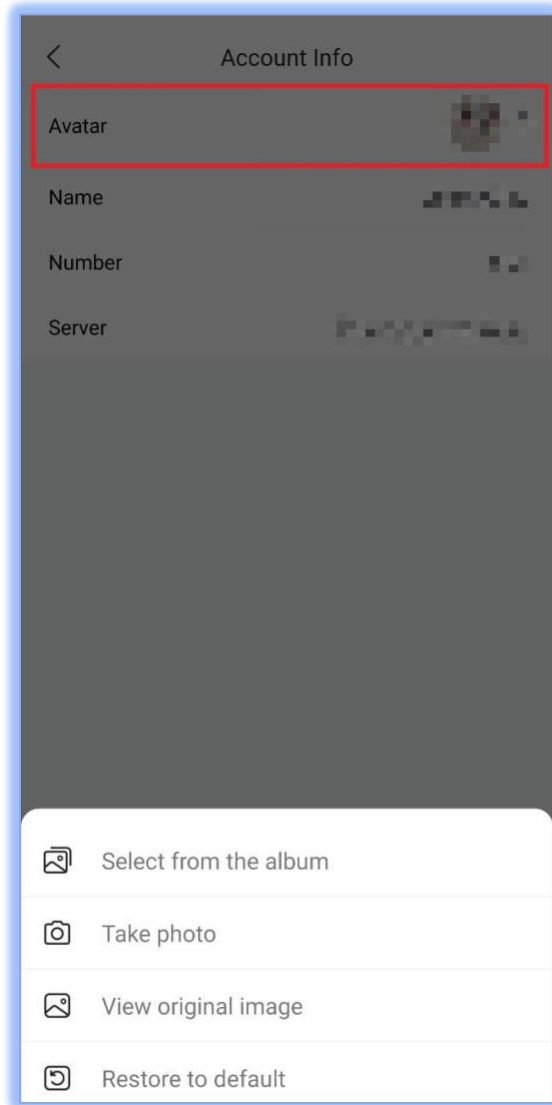


Figure 5 - Account Info

Tapping on *Avatar* will bring up the above options. Select the desired option for the new profile picture.

MEETING CHAT PREVIEW BUBBLES

Chat preview bubbles offer an unobtrusive way to read chat messages during meetings. If enabled, the latest chat messages will briefly appear on the bottom left corner of the screen for about 7 seconds before disappearing.

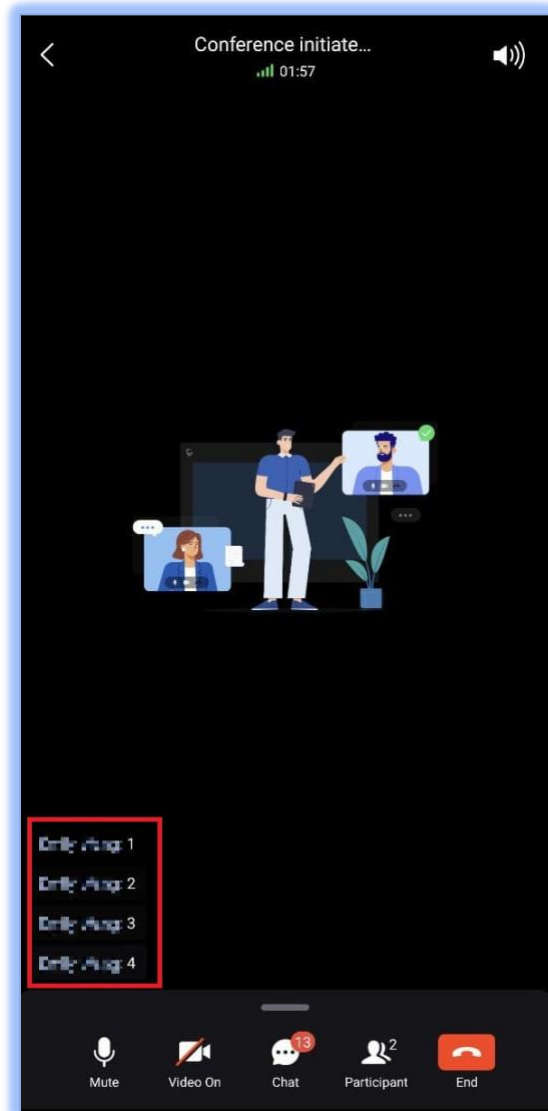


Figure 6 - Chat Preview Bubbles

To disable this feature, tap on the bottom tab's bar above the chat icon or swipe up from the bottom bar. The following options will appear:

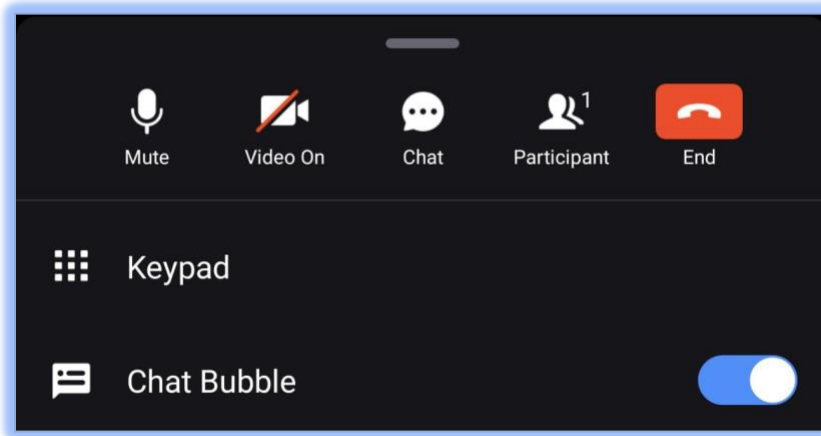


Figure 7 - Chat Bubble Toggle

Tap on the *Chat Bubble* toggle to enable/disable the feature.

SMART DEVICE

Wave can serve as a controller for other IP devices. This feature is limited to door systems for now.

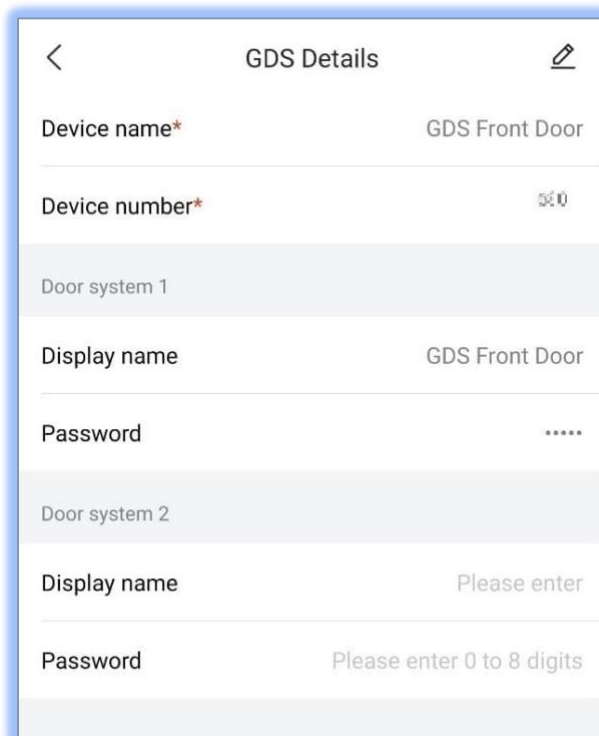


Figure 6 - Door System

For example, users can add a GDS door system to Wave, and this will allow Wave to receive a call when someone rings the door system. From here, Wave users can open the door or talk directly to visitor.

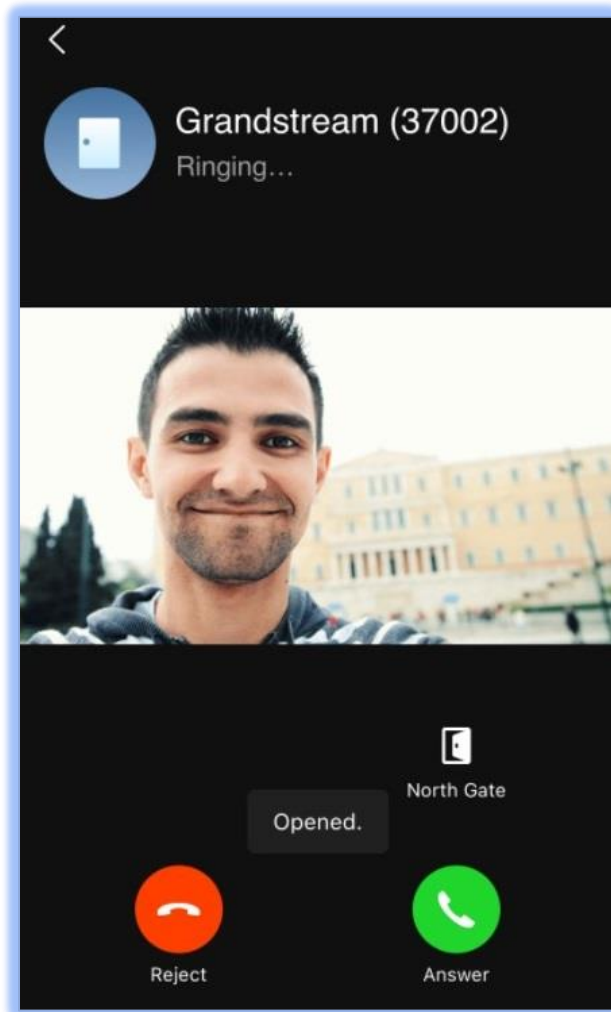


Figure 7 - Call from Door System

Currently, up to 10 door systems can be added to each Wave account.
