#### **ENHANCEMENTS**

- [Meeting] Added additional features for Whiteboard. [NEW WHITEBOARD FEATURES]
- [Meeting] Added a speaker indicator. [MEETING SPEAKER INDICATOR]
- [Meeting] Users will now receive calls when invited to an ongoing meeting.
- **[Call]** Added additional buttons to the audio call interface.
- [Call] Added option to use system dialer app make emergency calls. [EMERGENCY CALL]
- [Chat] Added ability to preview links in Chat window. [CHAT LINK PREVIEW]
- **[Application]** Added notification assistant for UCM's Message Broadcast feature. These messages will be displayed on the Wave chat interface.
- [Application] Added several new menu options: What's New, SDK Integration Development Instructions, Add-in Integration Development Document.
- [Application] Added support for UCM's "Delete Chat" Wave permission.
- [Application] Added new settings: Call Waiting, Call Waiting Tone, Contact Sort Order ("Last Name, First Name" or "First Name, Last Name"), Keep Application Running on Close.

# **NEW WHITEBOARD FEATURES**

The Whiteboard now includes more collaboration tools such as laser pointer, highlighter, text boxes, graphics, flow charts, charts and other graphics and styles. These graphics can be moved, drawn over and edited repeatedly. Users can even just use a simple brush or pen to quickly draw and visualize their points.




Figure 1: Whiteboard Interface - I

# **EMERGENCY CALL**

Users can opt to automatically use their system's default dialer app to place calls to configured Emergency Numbers on the UCM. This new setting is called **Use system default dialer for emergency calls** and is found in the **Settings** page.




Figure 4 - Emergency call



#### **MEETING SPEAKER INDICATOR**

Meetings can now have a real-time indicator of the current speaker.




Figure 5: Display Current Speaker

This can be toggled on/off by swiping up on the meeting toolbar shown or hidden from the **Settings** page.




Figure 6 - Display Speaker Identity Option

Users can now preview links sent in chat. Click on the link will open it through the in-app browser.




Figure 7: Preview Links in Chat
